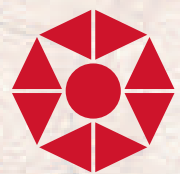

THE ABORIGINAL PEOPLE OF AUSTRALIA HAVE A CULTURE AND TRADITIONS THAT STRETCH BACK INTO THE MISTS OF TIME. THESE PEOPLE HAVE A SPECIAL RELATIONSHIP WITH THE ANIMALS, BIRDS, PLANTS AND THE VERY LANDSCAPE ITSELF. SPEND TIME DISCOVERING THE SPIRITUAL 'DREAMING', TRADITIONAL SKILLS, FOODS AND MEDICINES OF THE COASTAL WETLANDS, THE MURRAY RIVER SYSTEM OR FLINDERS RANGES. EXPLORE AND SHARE THIS ANCIENT CULTURE.

ABORIGINAL CULTURAL EXPERIENCE 4WD 1 DAY

Travel through the Adelaide Hills, Mt Lofty Ranges, Lake Alexandrina to Wellington ** Cross the river by ferry and travel down to the Aboriginal community of Raukkan ** Travel along to the Coorong taking in the wetlands and wildlife ** At 'Camp Coorong' you will have the chance to meet and share the traditional culture of the Ngarrindjeri people ** Join in with some traditional activities and listen to a 'Dreaming' presentation

TOUR DEPARTS DAILY AT 7:00AM AND RETURNS 5:30PM MINIMUM 2 PASSENGERS FOR DEPARTURE (subject to availability)

ABORIGINAL CULTURAL EXPERIENCE 4WD 2 DAY

DAY 1

Travel through the Adelaide Hills, Mt Lofty Ranges, Lake Alexandrina to Wellington ** Cross the river by ferry and travel down to the Aboriginal community of Raukkan ** Travel along to the Coorong taking in the wetlands and wildlife ** At 'Camp Coorong' you will have the chance to meet and share the traditional culture of the Ngarrindjeri people ** Join in with some traditional activities and listen to a 'Dreaming' presentation ** Then travel onto Parnka Point and onto Policeman's Point where you will spend the night

DAY 2

Choose between a 4WD ride down the beach or a guided kayaking tour of the Coorong (at own cost) ** Take a 4WD tour up to Salt Creek Roadhouse ** Explore the 90 miles of uninterrupted beach ** Cross the sand hills and stroll along the shell-studded beach ** Travel along the scenic Loop Road and stop for lunch at the Coorong Wilderness Lodge ** Hear the Ngarrindjeri Creation Story and take an Aboriginal Guided Bushwalk

TOURS INCLUDE PICK UP AND SET DOWN IN ADELAIDE 4WD GUIDED TOURING CAMP COORONG 'HANDS ON' MUSEUM MORNING TEA AND LUNCHES ALL PARK FEES AND PERMITS ACCOMMODATION (2 DAY TOURS) OPTIONAL GUIDED KAYAKING TOUR (OWN COST) COORONG WILDERNESS LODGE GUIDED BUSH WALK (2 DAY TOUR)

TOUR DEPARTS DAILY AT 7:00AM AND RETURNS 5:30PM THE FOLLOWING DAY MINIMUM 2 PASSENGERS FOR DEPARTURE (subject to availability)
